

About the Kildorrery GAA "Seat for Life" Scheme

In 2010, Kildorrery GAA Club formed a finance committee to oversee the fund-raising efforts of the club. The objective of the Committee was to raise funds for the day to day running of the club and further improve the facilities for Players and Spectators alike. In 2011 the Committee launched a two phased project consisting of a hurling wall in Phase 1 and the erection of a Spectator Stand in Phase 2. A very successful night at the Dogs raised sufficient funds to commence Phase 1. We got tremendous support throughout the whole parish for this fundraiser and it was a night to remember in Curraheen Park. The Building of Phase 1 has now Commenced.

After much careful thought and consideration, to enable us complete Phase 2 of this project, the fund-raising committee conceived the idea of a "Seat for Life" scheme, whereby club members, members of the public and Kildorrery GAA supporters across the globe, could be represented at the Club in a unique way. The "Seat for Life" scheme gives us all the opportunity to leave a lasting legacy for the generations to come. It is our chance to honour our fellow clubmen and women, living and dead, who have shaped GAA in this Club and Parish. Perhaps you want to declare your own unwavering commitment to our club? Perhaps a great GAA follower has

passed away, and you would like to dedicate a seat in his or her memory? Naming a seat in our new stand will ensure that your family's contribution and support of our club are witnessed by all throughout the County and further afield who visit our club. For each Seat for Life purchased, a Plaque bearing your chosen inscription will be placed on a seat in the Stand. When the Seat for life scheme is fully subscribed, we will be in a position to complete Phase 2 (Stand) without drawing on Club funds which are needed for the day to day running of the Club.

This scheme is a very ambitious one, and one which we hope all Club members and supporters will fully support. The pricing structure was decided after much debate and discussion. We fully understand the financial pressures club members are under at this current time. Each seat dedication in the new Stand costs €100 if purchased by a one-off payment. By choosing the easy payment instalment option, 10 monthly instalments of €10 can be made.
