




Resulting from increased participation rates over the last number of years, the club decided to embark on an ambitious project to redevelop the existing "Juvenile Pitch" into a **90 x 60 all-weather training facility**, fully floodlit and fenced with retaining wall (EGM 2022) and we are delighted to say we are very near completion. The entire cost of the project was approximately €600,000.

This was funded by several sources, including our own KDY GAA Film Awards fundraiser, Cork's Fittest Superstars and Sport Capital Grant of €147k. The Club has applied for Leader & Clár Funding and will be applying for Munster Council GAA Grant Aid in September 2025.
